¹Players who were born on or after July 1, 2006 and a high school student in the twelfth (12th) grade or below during some part of the current academic year are eligible to compete in 18 & under.

*Male Only - Players who were born on or after July 1, 2011 OR players who were born on or after July 1, 2010 (15 years or younger) who shall neither have completed nor are in a grade higher than the eighth (8th) grade during the current academic year are eligible to play in the 14 & Under division. This is because the net height difference of 7'4 1/8" to 7'11 5/8" between the 14 and Under Division to the 15 and Under Division.

4Male Only - Players who were born on or after July 1, 2011 (14 years or younger) who shall neither have completed nor are in a grade higher than the seventh grade (7th) during the current academic year are eligible for a Region approved waiver to compete in the boys 13's age group.

²⁴Players in this age range that have graduated high school are ineligible only if they have been enrolled at a university, college, community college or junior college AND have been cleared to participate by that (volleyball) program.

²⁶Players who were born on or after July 1, 2007, (who are defined as 18 & under by the USAV Age Definition) and are in the 11th grade for the current academic year are eligible to compete in 17 & under.







Player Code of Conduct

Players will follow ALL gym rules with the utmost respect at all times. No arguing with or ignoring gym staff/rules.

Players will receive a complimentary membership to use the facility as long as they are actively enrolled in club and have no outstanding balances.

Players may NOT at any time bring family members or friends into the gym for free. All guest who do not have a gym membership must pay a court fee.

Players will check in at the front desk when using the facility EXCEPT during their designated practice time. This means NO sneaking through the back doors.

Any player who is found in violation to these rules can/will be dismissed from the team.

**By completing signups and making the initial payment, you are acknowledging that you have read and understand the code of conduct and agree/commit to abiding by the policies published by CEVA at the link above.

Purple Card Policy: CEVA implements a Purple Card policy at ANY region hosted tournaments. A purple card can be awarded to any fan/parent that shows blatant disregard for rules or personnel involved in a match. This included officials, scorekeepers, coaches etc. If any of our parents/fans receive a purple card, we will review it on a case by case basis. We take this offense very seriously and want to state that this offense is clearly a grounds for dismissing a family/player from club participation.

Parent Code of Conduct Cont..

We have a strict 24 Hour Policy for the entire club.

- -Do not contact the coach for 24 hours after a tournament to give constructive feedback of any kind.
- -The coach will then have 24 hours to respond to any received input.
- -Parents Main Duty-Buy Ice Cream and DON'T talk volleyball.
- -Parents should promote communication by the kids directly with coaches, in a practice or tournament setting at appropriate times.

We highly encourage giving positive feedback to coaches at any time.

G3 Membership Discount

G3 Sports & Fitness is offering a membership discount to immediate family members of players who are **actively** enrolled in Club or Academy

Pricing is \$25/month per person with NO initiation fee. Membership provides FULL access to all of G3's amenities (Fitness Floor, Courts, Spa, Classes, etc.)

Your player MUST be actively enrolled in either Club or Academy to maintain this discount. Stop by the front desk anytime to sign up or if you have any questions!

Common Questions:

Will the girls that didn't make a team get a call?

No. We are in a rush to get teams registered/sizes submitted/players paperwork done and tournaments applied to as soon as teams are formed.

What if my child has a schedule conflict?

Club teams will accommodate on a team by team basis, see your coach regarding scheduled club practices/tournaments.

What if I have multiple children playing club?

Families with multiple children participating in club will be handled on an individual basis

Common Questions Cont...

• If I didn't make a club team, can I still come to Academy?

Yes! We encourage players who do not make a team to continue developing their skills through academy. Some of our best players didn't make a club team as a younger player.

- If I play for another club, can I still come to Academy?
 Yes.
- Who pays for hotels and airfare?

Parents pay for hotels and airfare for themselves and their player. Their player also stays in the room with them. Players can and do travel with other families. Permission is handled away from coaches.

• Can I put my child's academy membership on hold during the club season? Yes.

Common Questions Cont...

Do you offer beach volleyball?

Beach club starts in June. That is a different club season with separate fees.

Are there any non-travel teams this year?

The teams we are able to offer this year are discussed in this presentation.

Where are power leagues located?

Up and down I5. Power league locations are released the week before each tournament. Location is determined based on ranking
